• ASVAB Testing: Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) testing will take place Tuesday, November 14, 2023 in the PAC. It will begin at 9:00 a.m. and will last approximately 3 hours. The ASVAB

test is a multiple-aptitude battery test that measures developed abilities and helps predict future academic occupational success. If your student is interested in taking the test, they can sign up by logging into their Schoolinks account and sign up under the "School Events" tab at the top. Or they can stop by the College and Career Corner (room 200D) and speak to one of the counselors.
