Happy Sunday HHS Parents/Guardians,

We had a great couple days last week. We welcomed 2,047 students Thursday and an additional 50 or so Friday. We are projected to have approximately 2,250 this year, so we will see. With respect to communication, my plan is to send this Principal Update twice a month. I know a few have already gone out this year. There are many important things to share as we successfully kick off the school year so here we go!

- > Student Schedules: Schedule changes will be underway this week. Students were given access Friday to sign up to see their counselor via Code flyer. This flyer was shared with them today directly via Parent Square as well.
- ➤ Arrival and Dismissal Pick Up/Drop Off:
 - **Arrival:** Student arrival/drop off went well Thursday and Friday. Having the staggering drop off really helps.
 - Oismissal: We are still working on this. We were able to get your students in your cars faster Friday than Thursday, so that was good. Though the dismissal traffic is not ideal, everyone was being PATIENT, KIND, and SAFE! THANK YOU VERY MUCH! Continue to watch out for our junior and senior drivers as they walk to their cars. We will continue to work to improve this process.
- ➤ HB114: Did you know? House Bill 114 was passed by the 88th Texas Legislature, and will affect required disciplinary action that Hutto ISD will be implementing beginning in the 2023-2024 school year. This bill requires a mandatory placement into a Disciplinary Alternative Education Program (DAEP) for offenses related to e-cigarettes/nicotine vapes. Therefore, students who use, sell, or possess e-cigarettes will have the same consequence as those possessing vapes which contain THC (cannabis/marijuana extract).
