Happy Sunday HHS Parents/Guardians,

Hope you and your family had a great week last week. *It's showtime!* Our students' first day of school for the 23-24 school year will be this **Thursday, August 10th**. No new students will be registered on day one. HHS doors will open at 8:20am, classes will begin at 9am, and students will be released at 4:25pm. Here's our <u>23-24 HHS Regular Bell Schedule</u>. This communication will be shared with your student as well because there are many things they need to know as well. My apologies for the length. *Here we go!*

- ➤ Student Schedules: Student schedules will be ready to view in Skyward on Wednesday, August 9th. The majority of our 2230 schedules are done. However, we are continuing to enroll new students and we are making changes to accommodate for teacher vacancies in some courses. Once you see your student's schedules on August 9th, please do not reach out to the counselors for schedule changes. Doing so would hinder the counselor's ability to make the final scheduling adjustments before we welcome our students Thursday, August 10th. Our admin team and counselors will address scheduling issues the first couple weeks of school. Thank you for your patience and understanding at this time.
 - Schedule Pick Up Day #1: A list of all student's first period classes will be displayed in the cafeteria and in the hallways. Educators will assist students with locating their first period (all) classes. Students will report to their first period class and that's when they will receive a paper copy of their schedule.
- ➤ Arrival and Dismissal Pick Up/Drop Off: Safety and security are priorities at HHS. The arrival and dismissal procedures have been designed to keep all stakeholders safe and to eliminate any confusion at the start and at the end of the school day. You and your student(s) adhering to the arrival and dismissal procedures are critical in making our student drop off and pick up safe, secure, and successful. The safe transfer of the custody of your student is of utmost importance. There is no need to hurry. BE PATIENT, BE KIND, and BE SAFE! The first day and couple weeks will be our trial run and our time to perfect our traffic patterns. Please be patient with us and please expect delays the first weeks of school.
 - Here is a <u>map</u> of the pick up and drop off traffic pattern. All pick up and drop off will take place in the back of the school by the gym off West Front Street.
