Hello HES Families-

Our annual fundraiser is a way to raise money to pay for various items that come up through the school year that our reugalr operating budget doesn't cover. If for some reason there is not an adult outside after 7:30, you will need to drive to our office entrance and park by the construction trailer and walk your child to the door to ring the doorbell. ANNOUNCEMENT FOR 2ND GRADE PARENTS

Beginning in the 2021-22 school year, all students in second grade will be assessed with the *Cognitive Ability Test (CogAT)* in the month of October. This is an assessment that we use to identify students for



giftedness. This practice will enable us to Identify students with exceptional ability or potential so that we may more equitably serve students, especially populations underrepresented in Gifted and Talented programming. Students will take this screener during the school day and it will take approximately 30-45 minutes. There is nothing you need to do to prepare your student for this screener. Based on the results of the CogAT screener, eligible students will be invited to complete the full GT testing battery in the Winter.
