Modes of Instruction				
Synchronous	Requires students and teacher to be present at the same time online. Examples: Live interactive classes with students and teachers participating in real-time through an online platform such as Google Classroom or Canvas Teacher-supported work time on video conference calls Scheduled and online assessments			
Asynchronous	Does not require students and teacher to be present online at the same time. Examples: Pre-assigned work with formative assessment on paper or in a learning management system such as Google Classroom or Canvas Pre-recorded videos of instruction Practice and assessment in educational software programs such as Freckle or Renaissance
